

I was also personally invited as administrator of the issfanclub.eu website and president of the newly formed cultural association.










The kit for the participants: an accurate dossier collected all the presentations, some of which were translated into English, and the day's program with a precise timeline of the planned activities.



Greet the participants and opens the day Slawek SQ3OOK, followed by Armand SP3QFE which presents radio communications with the ISS.





After the lunch break. We're not all in this picture. 80 people attended the conference.



Tomasz Salwach SQ6QV, OM active in the satellite amateur radio TV, tells us about his experiences. The legendary MiniTiouner is in the room!






We saw a video of Paolo Nespoli received from Armand's HamTv Ground Station, hoping to get HamVideo back on the ISS soon for new transmissions ...



We are almost closing, Krzystof Poporski SQ7IQA presents a model of great educational interest.








